

The 12th annual Guide Dogs of America Golf Tournament will be a one-day tournament held Saturday, July 23rd at <u>Gleneagle Golf Course in Arlington</u>. The cost of this year's tournament will be \$110, which covers green fees, cart rental, tournament t-shirt and lunch at the end of play.

This organization created by a merger in 2020 provides guide dogs to visually impaired individuals and service dogs to individuals with disabilities across the U.S.

The tournament will be a "scramble" format with a shotgun start at <u>9:00 a.m.</u> for all golfers. Cash prizes will be awarded to the first and second place teams, long drive, and closest to pin.
