At this time, and in order to maximize our potential monetary contributions to this worthwhile and deserving charity, we are respectfully requesting donations in the form of prizes and /or funds.

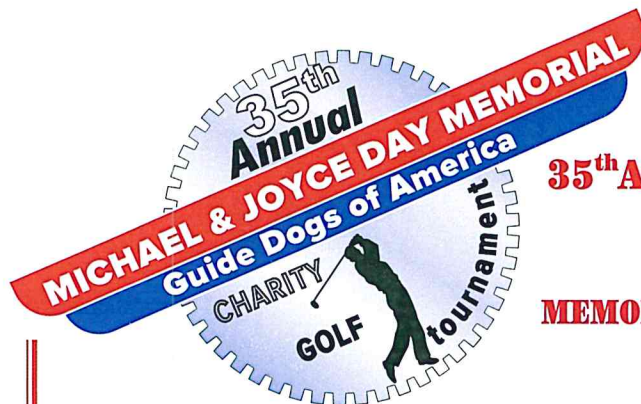
